So, I sense...

From our group's perspective we've said nothing but LOINC and so I'm not sure where that came from like as Clem says. So, let's find out.

Sure, Michelle, do you just want to show the slides so people can have a visual of the ones we're looking at? So, for Group One assignment we had a combination from the NPRM of medication, laboratory, diagnostic assignments for our group and we had one meeting last week, we have 11 pieces that we were asked to review.

Our first meeting really helped define how we were going to move forward, it took about 15 minutes for us to get a WebEx so we only had about 45 minutes on the call and we got through two of the bullets. We skipped around because Clem was on the call and I wanted to make sure to get his expertise on the laboratory part since we had him on.

And so we did the CPOE for laboratory and the CPOE for diagnostic imaging and some of the things that we realized as we were going through it we had the summary sheets but within the NPRM there are kind of questions peppered throughout so for example with the CPOE for laboratory there were questions about conclude data elements secondary diagnosis codes, reasons for order comment fields entered by the provider if they are provided to the ordering provider in their system.

So, like when we made our comments there were also things about eDOS which I wasn't super familiar with but I'm going to put it in my pharmacy terms that I am familiar with. To me the eDOS is similar to like the drug compendium so like the first databanks, the goal, the...and so we were trying to figure out like the hierarchy, so we wanted to make sure like LOIs defined as the lab order entry and it's not dependent on whether the eDOS is available or not so we don't want people to get confused with that.

And then with...to understand what the cardinality is and then also for the diagnostic imaging like with the reasons for ordering we thought that was really important because typically for diagnostic imaging you need the ordering to be able to bill for it, so to be able to send that electronically felt like it would be a big help.

So, those are the two that we looked at and Michelle does that go out to the group like as we're doing it or we just kind of talk about it here and then once we're complete the group will look over it to comment more?
