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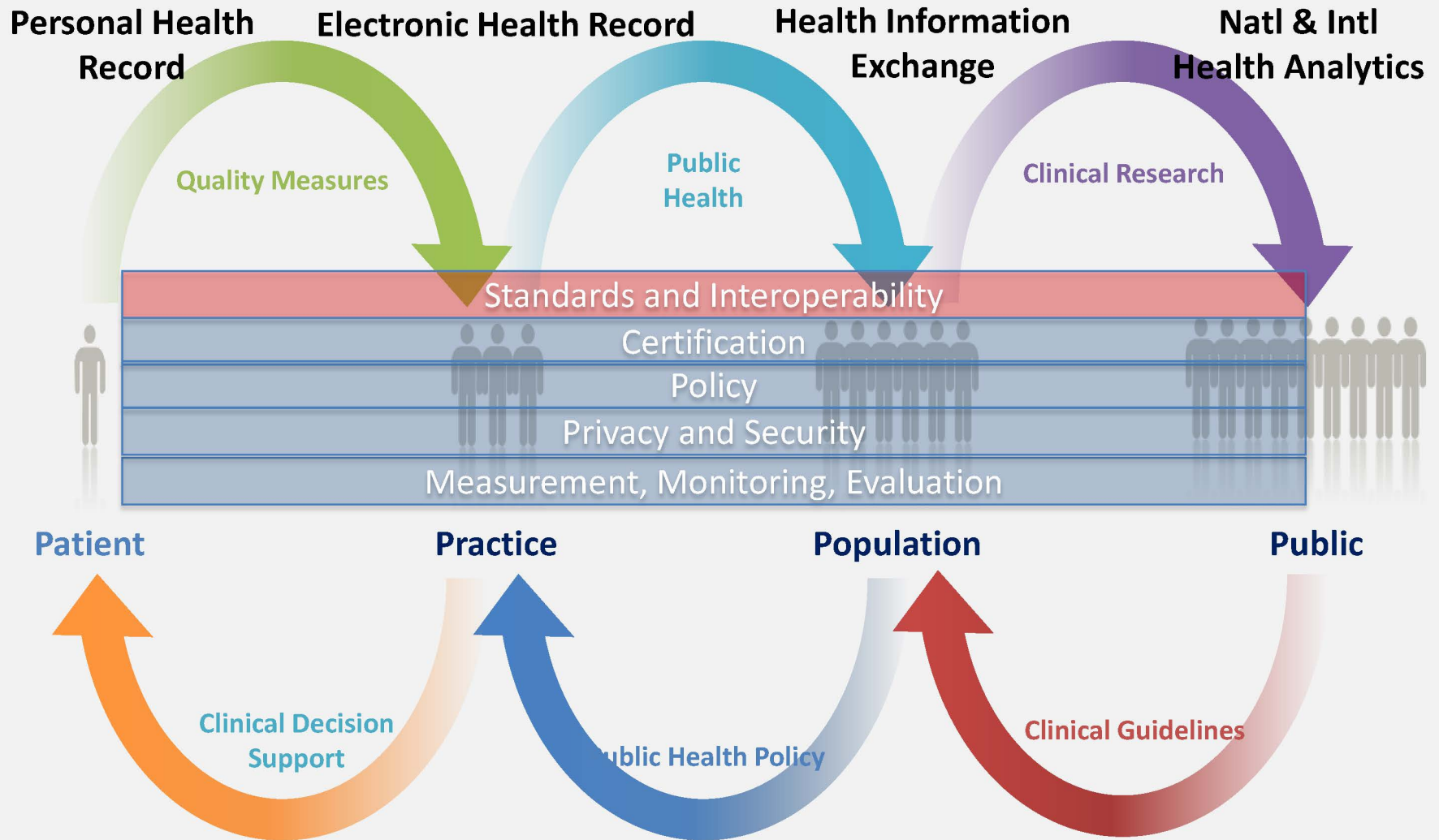

Provider Data Migration and Patient Portability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To enable patients who switch providers to have their care continue seamlessly (no repeat tests, missing key clinical information etc.). • To enable providers switching EHR systems to continue providing seamless care to patients (coded data in old system is consumable by the new system so clinical decision support still works) 	<u>11/14/13</u>	NwHIN PT

- Meaningful Use WG final recommendations to HITPC on March 11th
- HITSC MU feedback
 - Some HITSC members have provided feedback
 - Poll all HITSC members
 - Formation of a task force to consolidate and provide rapid feedback
 - Review feedback at March 26th HITSC
- Task force - looking for 5-6 volunteers

- New approach to certification
 - Allows for certification criteria to be updated more frequently
 - Improve on the 2014 Edition
 - Responsive to stakeholder feedback
 - Address issues
 - Reference updated standards and implementation guides
- Voluntary
 - Participants in the EHR Incentive Programs won't need to upgrade
 - EHR technology certified to the 2014 Edition will not need to recertify
- NPRM forthcoming
 - HITSC workgroups will be asked to respond
