Testing Components: Health IT developer self-declaration to the testing outcomes

Test Procedure Version 1.1 – Last Updated 09/21/17

Note: The order in which the test steps are listed reflects the sequence of the certification criterion and does not necessarily prescribe the order in which the test should take place.

Required Tests

(a)(7) Medication List. Enable a user to record, change, and access a patient's active medication list as well as medication history:

(i) Ambulatory setting only. Over multiple encounters.

Standard(s): None

Criteria ¶	System Under Test	Test Lab Verification
(i)	 The user selects a patient record and accesses the active medication list, which includes entries created over multiple previous encounters and records a new medication. The user accesses the patient's record for the active medication list, which includes entries for medications entered over multiple encounters and changes the active medication list. 	 The tester verifies the user can access a patient's medication list that has been created over multiple encounters and that the new entry is added to the patient's active medication list. The tester verifies that the changes to the medication list are reflected in the patient's active medication list.



(a)(7)(ii) Inpatient setting only. For the duration of an entire hospitalization. Standard(s): None

(ii)	 The user selects a patient and accesses the active medication list, which includes entries for the duration of an entire hospitalization and records a new medication. The user accesses the patient's record for the active medication list, which includes entries for the duration of an entire hospitalization and changes the active medication list. 	 The tester verifies the user can access a patient's active medication list that includes entries for the duration of an entire hospitalization and the new entry is added to the patient's active medication list. The tester verifies that the changes to the medication list are reflected in the patient's active medication list.
