

Test Data for §170.314(b)(4) Clinical information reconciliation

Reference the test procedure for test data implementation guidance.

RxNorm codes, National Drug Code (NDC) product codes, and SNOMED CT[®] codes are not required to meet this certification criterion. They are provided for reference only. All source and date data are Vendor-supplied; no standard format is required; dates are to include month, day and year.

Last modification date is interpreted differently for each data type. For medication list, last modification date should be interpreted as the last date the medication was document, ordered, prescribed, refilled, dispensed, or edited. For problem list, last modification date should be interpreted as the last date the problem was documented or edited. For medication allergy list, last modification date should be interpreted as the last date the medication allergy was documented, edited, or updated.
