## Measure ID and Version: Interop\_Standards\_4\_v1

**Measure Title:** Electronic Health Information (EHI) Export through Certified Health IT

### Measure Description

- *Regulatory Reference:* 42 CFR § 170.407(a)(7)
- *Associated Certification Criteria:* 42 CFR § 170.315(b)(10)
- This measure captures the use of certified health IT to export single patient and patient population EHI.

### Count

- The number of full data EHI exports requests processed during the reporting period.

### Attestation

- “We enable direct-to-individual EHI exports”
  - “Yes”
  - “No”

### Stratifications

- *Count:*
  - The count should be reported by the following subgroups:
    - Single patient EHI export
    - Patient population EHI Export

### Definitions

- None

### Supplemental Reporting Information

- **Required:** Reports shall include counts and be aggregated at the product level (across versions)
- **Required:** Developers shall submit documentation on the data sources and collection methods
- **Optional:** Developers may also submit descriptive or qualitative information to provide context

### Notes

- The ONC Cures Act Final Rule (85 CFR 25695) EHI Export certification criterion in § 170.315(b)(10) does not require “direct-to-patient” functionality in order for a developer to demonstrate conformance to the criterion. However, this functionality is not precluded.

### Exclusions

- Products that are not certified to 42 CFR § 170.315(b)(10) are excluded from this measure.

- *Measure Area:* Standards Adoption and Conformance
- *Measure Category:* Interoperability

## Expected Metrics

- Count of full data EHI export requests processed by single patient and patient population requests
- Whether or not the Certified Health IT Module supports direct-to-individual EHI exports
