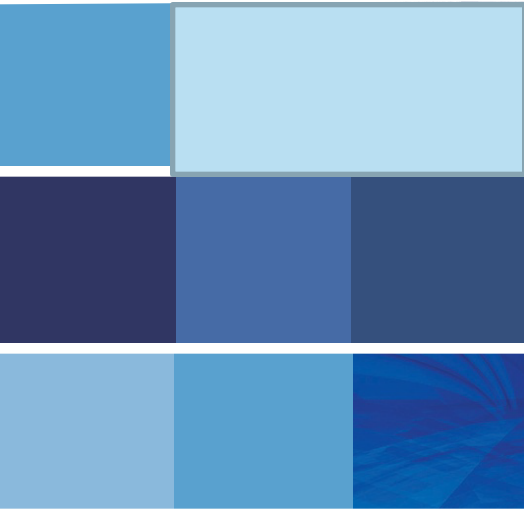
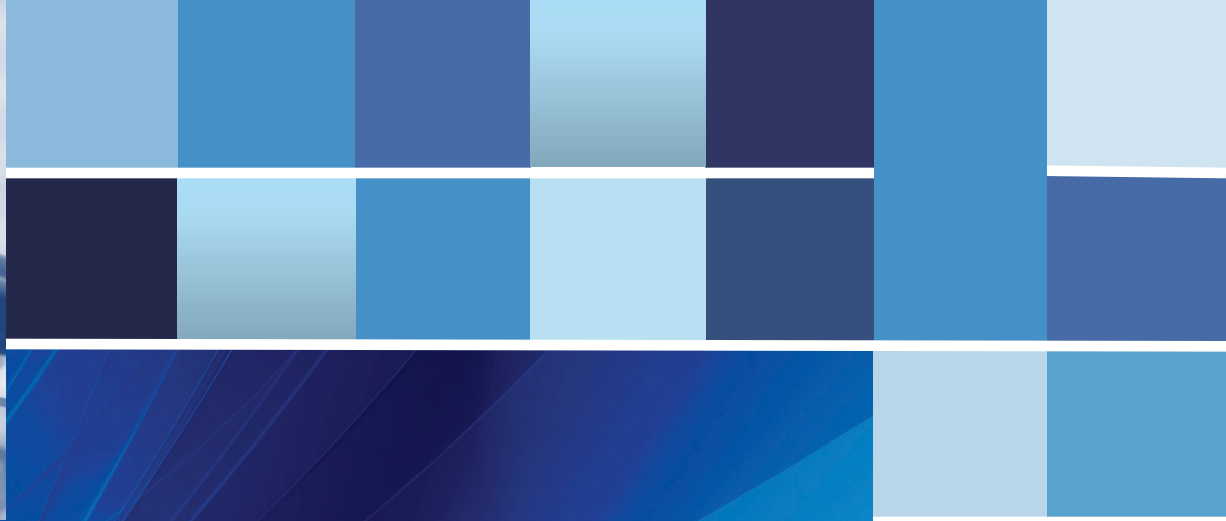

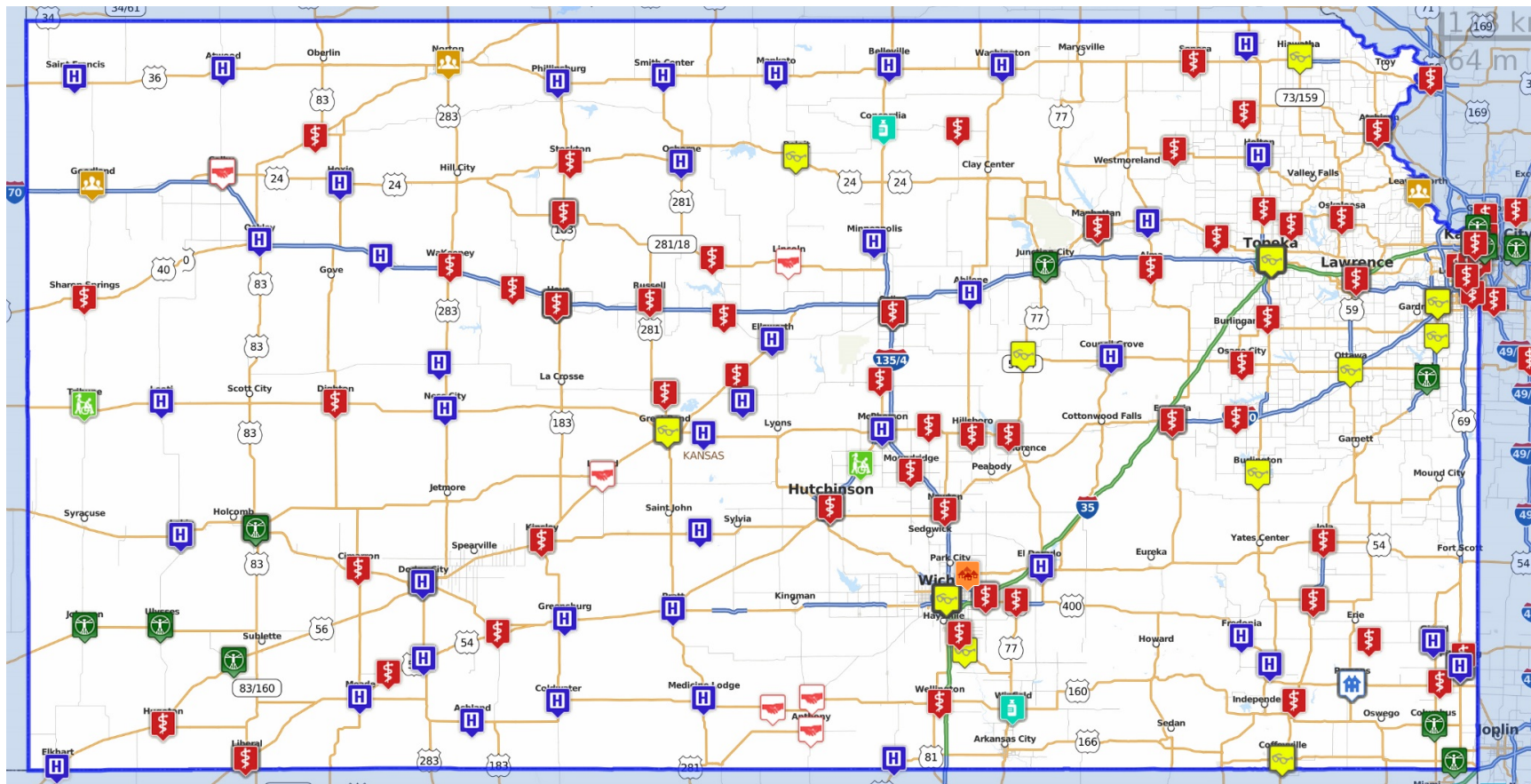

42 CFR Part 2 Patient Consent considerations for data sharing

Two Options

1. Block Data at the EHR level.

Concerns:

- Data is NOT available in an emergency
- Data is NOT available when a patient gives consent

2. Block Data at the HIE level.

Concerns:

- On going communication between provider and HIE
- Notification of security override without patient consent



Barriers to Behavioral Health EHR Participation in KHIN
