




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

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Nearly 70% of U.S. physicians are employed by hospitals or corporate entities

The acquisition of private physician practices across the U.S. accelerated after the onset of the pandemic.

AI is at risk for inequitable implementation



- ✓ Low minority representation at Al's largest Companies
 - McKinsey & Company's 2022 report- 29% of companies surveyed said they had no minorities working on AI solutions
- ✓ Post- Secondary Education Institution's Faculty Pipeline Stats:
 - 73% White, 12% Asian, 6% Black, 6% Latino, < 1% American Indian/Alaskan Native or Pacific Islander
 - High Research Institution have very low percentage of Black Faculty < 4%
- ✓ Safety Net Providers have significant integrative & interoperable challenges
- ✓ Evidence shows that Digital Health Tools can impact Population Health if in the hands of Front-Line Providers
