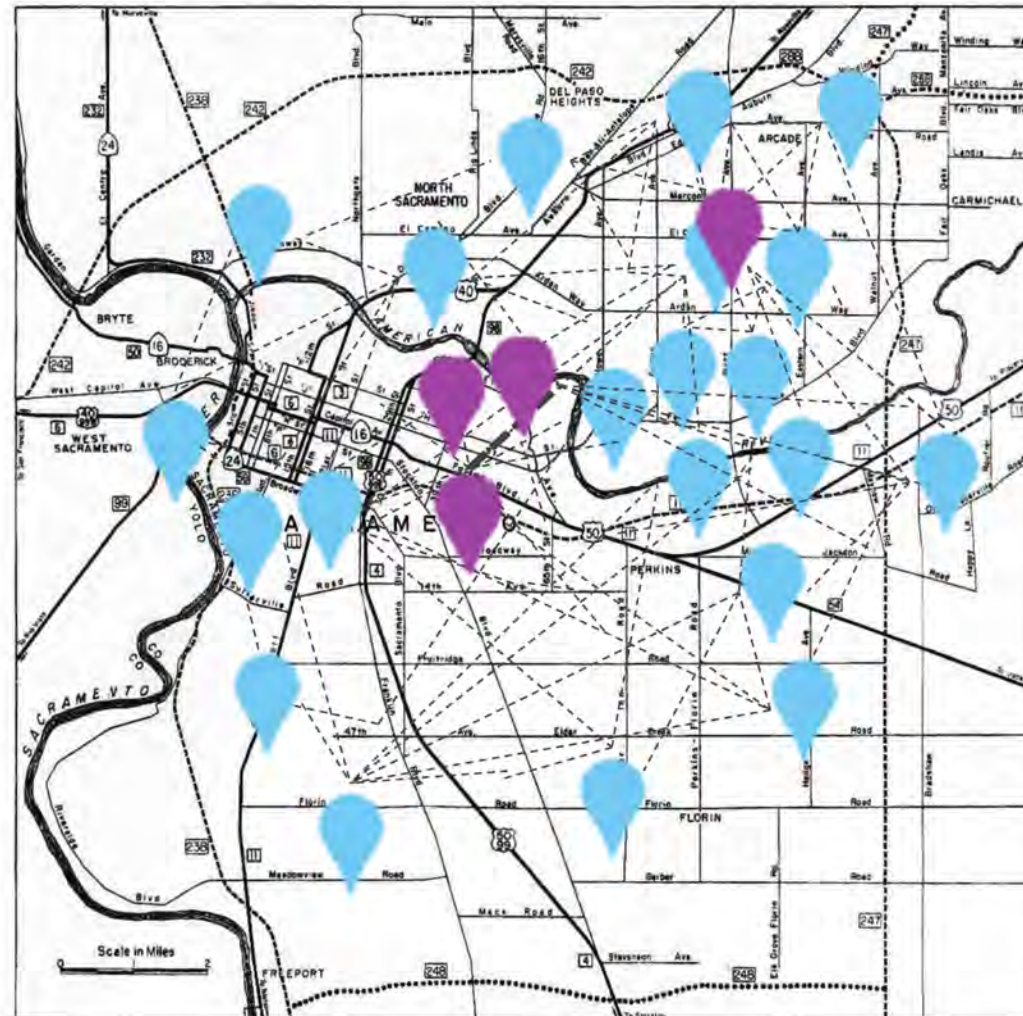
# Connecting the Community: The Opportunity

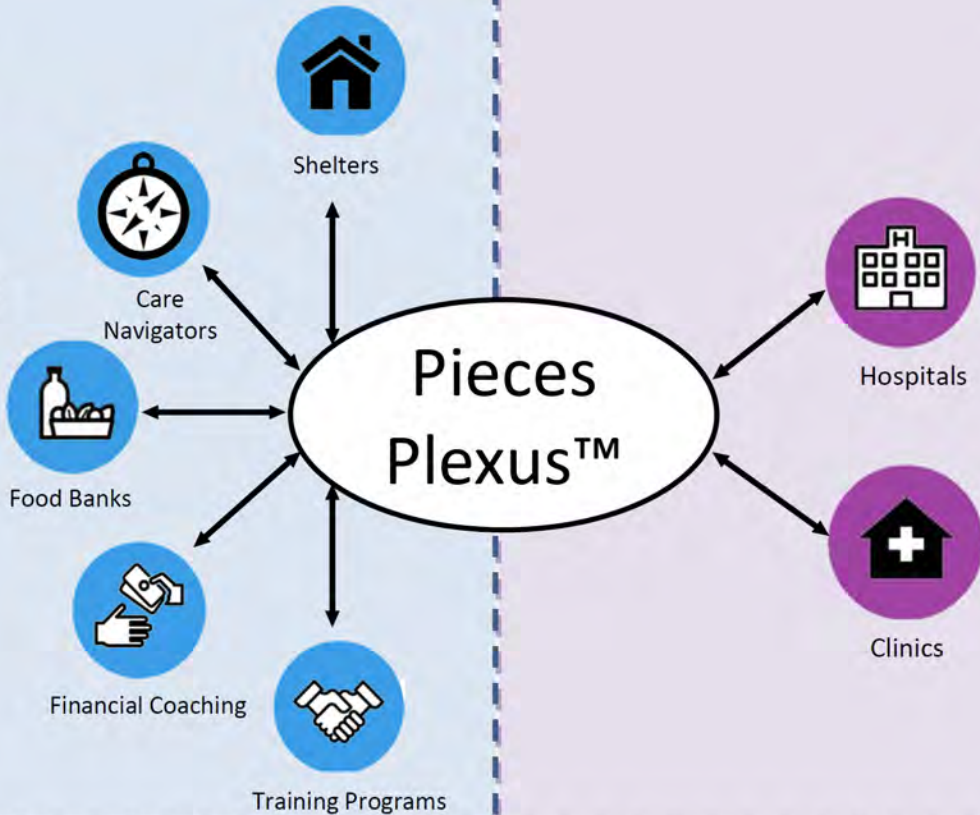
