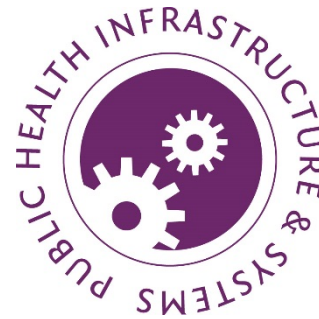

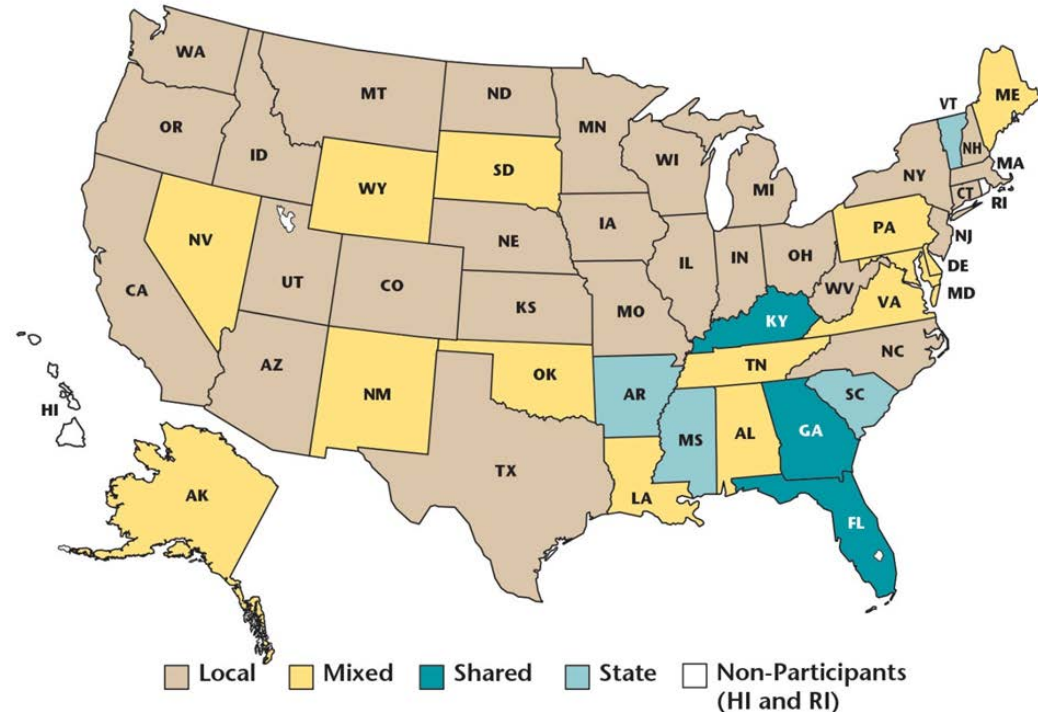

Governance of LHDs (by State)



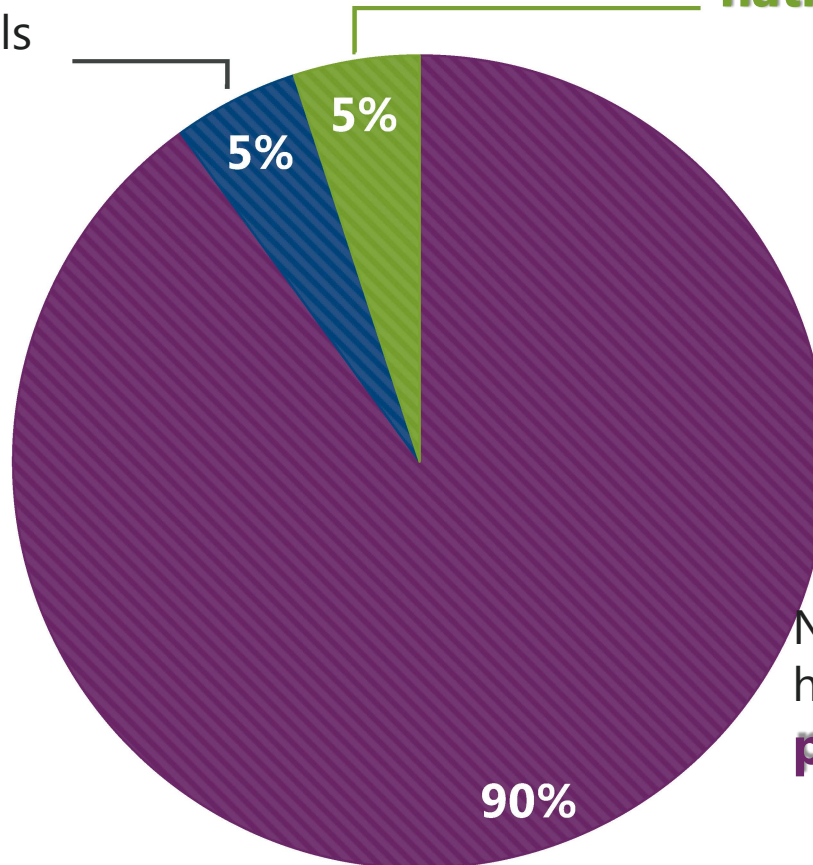
