- Significant exchange is occurring today
- Shift from HIE 1.0 to 2.0
- Payment reform is driving business needs for exchange
- Business drivers should select the technology not the other way around
- Data needs to be integrated into the providers workflow

- Cross vendor exchange is a must in 2013
