

Guidelines for Configuring and Priming the EHR for LRI Incorporation Testing

Certification Criterion

- §170.314(b)(5)(A) - Incorporate laboratory tests and values/results

General Instructions

Specific Instructions

- During routine certification testing for the §170.314(b)(5)(A) Incorporate laboratory tests and values/results criterion, the EHR Vendor will have pre-configured their application with a patient record that has the necessary information for linking/associating the LRI message and any other information necessary to facilitate incorporation
- Prior to sending the LRI test message to the EHR for each Test Case, the Authorized Test Lab (ATL) will examine the test patient's record to confirm that no lab results are filed in the patient's record
- After each LRI test message for each Test Case is sent to the EHR, the ATL will use the provided Juror Documents to verify display and incorporation of the lab data (follow test procedure for complete instructions)
- The ATL should modify slightly the test data in the provided test message (for example, modify a lab result value) prior to sending at least one of the LRI test messages to the EHR

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
