<u>Chest</u>: Lungs are resonant to percussion, w/o wheezes, rhonchi or crackles. Normal diaphragmatic excursion.

Cardiac: Regular no gallop, murmur.

Abdomen: Abdomen is soft, NT/NO, no bruit or hepatomegaly.

Genitourinary: Normal

Extremity: Lower extremities are warm, palpable pulses, trace edema. Brace on left

leg/foot.

Neurological: Alert, oriented.

DIAGNOSIS: Abrasion, whiplash injury.

PLAN: The abrasion was cleaned thoroughly and it was dressed with a sterile dressing. She will follow up with her orthopedist this week preferably tomorrow. Follow up with her primary as well.
