 - Corresponding Responsibility
 - A pharmacist is required to exercise sound professional judgment when making a determination about the legitimacy of a controlled substance prescription.
 - Such a determination is made before the prescription is dispensed.
- Pharmacists should have access to PDMP data prior to dispensing and clinical care
